RULES AND REGULATIONS

In order to provide a fun and safe environment for our drivers and their families, the following rules have been established. A first time warning will be given for failure to abide by any of these rules. ***Any further failure to comply by any family member will result in "family" removal from the property and immediate disqualification of driver(s).***

- **No alcoholic beverages of any kind are allowed on city property.**
- **No bicycles or skateboarding inside track.**
- **Beware of machinery.**
- **No one should be in Heritage Village except during demonstrations.**
- **Keep children away from roped off areas such as: sawmill, syrup mill, cotton bales.**
- **Be respectful of historical sections of the park.**
- **No smoking – no bicycling – no skateboarding in restroom facilities.**
- **No profanity.**
- **Pets must be on leash and you will be required to clean up after them.**
- **Any other instruction by track or city officials must be complied with the same as above.**

CUMMING FAIRGROUNDS RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Fairground buildings and Heritage Village exhibits are to be considered restricted areas at all times. No NGQMA participant or guests are allowed in these areas. The City of Cumming assumes no responsibility of damage to equipment, personal property, or injury to any spectator or participant anywhere within the Fairgrounds and racetrack venue during NGQMA club activities.
2. During major fairground events the NGQMA will not be allowed to park on the fairgrounds. During the annual Cumming Country Fair & Festival the race track parking lot will be reserved for fairground business for all eleven days.
3. After regular scheduled races all trailers should be removed from the fairgrounds (the fairgrounds is not a trailer storage area).
4. The NGQMA will keep the race track area and fairgrounds area clean and safe.
5. Only licensed vehicles with a licensed operator will be permitted on Fairground roadways. No motorcycles, mopeds, "four wheelers" or golf carts allowed except whose designated "Official Use Only" for NGQMA race personnel or race officials.
6. No bicycles, skateboards, or roller blades allowed during organized events.
7. No pets allowed on the fairgrounds during organized events.
8. No alcoholic beverages allowed on the entire Cumming Fairgrounds property at any time.
9. Smoking is prohibited inside any fairground building, offices, arena and barn area.
10. All electrical extension cores must be twelve (12) gauge, three (3) wire negative ground type or heavier.
11. All trailers must be parked in an orderly fashion. All aisles and roadways must be kept open at all times due to fire regulations. Owners will be asked to move any vehicles or risk being towed, fined or both.
12. No posters, flyers, stickers or any other printed material or advertising is allowed on the fairgrounds unless otherwise approved by the Fairgrounds Administrator. No unauthorized solicitation.
13. The selling or use of silly string, poprocks and laser lights are prohibited on the fairground facility.
