Opening:

- Mark Mackie and Jack Miller will contact the webmasters for other clubs to post our races.
- A discussion was held on moving from QMA to USAC. A committee was formed to gather more information on both sanctioning bodies. The committee is Jack Miller, Mark Mackie, Roger Fugett, Michael Cochran, Janis Thomas and Sherry Taylor.
